83rd ANNUAL NZCA CONFERENCE 2026

The 83rd Annual Conference of the New Zealand Chinese Association (NZCA) was held at the Brentwood Hotel in Wellington on the weekend of 20th and 21st June. There were 66 delegates attending from branches throughout New Zealand. Canterbury branch delegates were Lois Yee (Canterbury President and National Vice President), Jared Chin (Co-chair LDC), Rhonda Ding, Emmie King, Daret Lowe, Karen Prisco, Fran Yee, Sonya Ng and Angelina King.

This year's conference theme, *Future Ready: Sustainability, Strategy and Governance*, was facilitated by Doris Sew Hoy. There were presentations and workshops on day one and AGM matters on day two to enable a more streamlined format and greater cross-Branch networking. The conference dinner held at the Grand Century Chinese Restaurant on Saturday evening was an opportunity to socialise over a delicious Chinese banquet menu.

- ◆ Network with like-minded Chinese New Zealanders

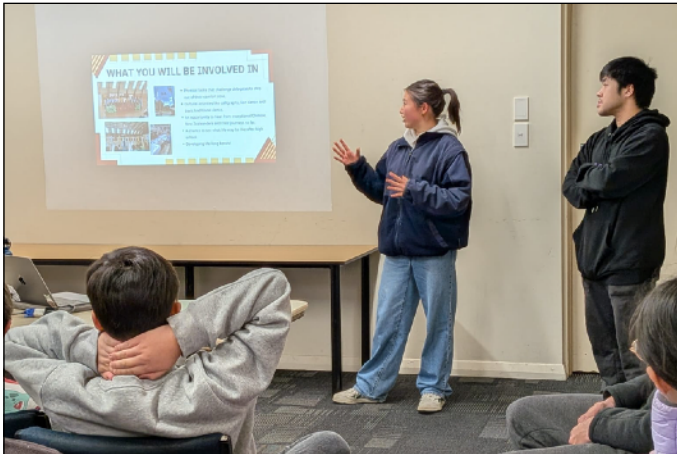

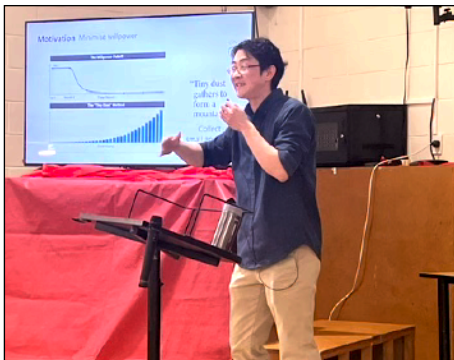
Family Board Games evening

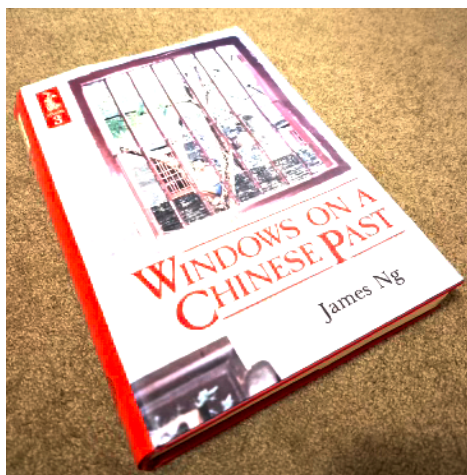


Jung Class
